

# 2nd Annual Fire Prevention Month Poster Contest

This year's contest will be held during Fire Prevention Week and is open to all 1<sup>st</sup> thru 5<sup>th</sup> grade students in the Lincolnshire-Prairie View School District 103.

## Contest Rules:

- † All entries must incorporate the 2024 Fire Prevention Week theme. This year's theme is:

***“Smoke alarms: Make them work for you!”***

- † Entries may be submitted on a poster board or paper. Maximum size 22" x 28". Any color is acceptable. NO 3-D posters (flat only.) Posters must be able to be hung on the wall without any material falling off.
- † Each entry **MUST** have the student's full name, grade, school name, and teacher's name on the back of the poster.  
  
The deadline for entries is at the end of the school day on **Friday, October 11th, 2024**.
- † Preliminary judging will be held the following week! A trophy will be awarded for each grade levels best poster along with ribbons for 2nd and 3rd place. All place winners will also receive gifts from other local businesses.
- † The overall poster that best depicts this year's theme will receive the grand prize trophy. The winner will then be entered into a regional competition with other local school districts who are participating in the same contest.
- † The Regional Champion will be judged on a date TBD. Once the winning poster is chosen, the winner will be notified, and an additional trophy will be awarded, crowning 2024's Regional Champion!
- † Posters will be returned to the schools and distributed back to the children later.
- † Ideas from parents are welcome, but all work should come from the children!
